In accordance with recommendations provided by our City Public Safety Staff and the Flagler County Health Department, our **City Beaches, Boardwalk and Pier will be closed; effective Monday, March 23, 2020 at 6:00 a.m.**

Our City Beaches, Boardwalk and Pier will remain closed until further notice.

The City of Flagler Beach hopes that our residents and visitors understand that the public's health and safety during this worldwide pandemic is our utmost concern. This rapidly changing crisis is fluid and dynamic, and we as a City kept our Beaches, Boardwalk and Pier open as long as it was safe for the health, safety and welfare of our community.
