COMMUNITY HAPPENINGS:

HHW COLLECTION EVENT:

Items Accepted:

- Paints and solvents
- New/used oil, transmission fluid, automotive coolant, etc.
- Oil filters
- Aerosols
- Pesticides, Herbicides and Fertilizer (See exclusions below)
- Epoxies and Catalyst components
- Flares
- Devices containing mercury
- Batteries
- Propane tanks no larger than 30 lb. capacity, fire extinguishers and carbon dioxide cylinders
- Fluorescent bulbs (straight tube or CFL)
- Pool chemicals
- Up to 3 tires per vehicle
- Electronic waste (See exclusions below)

Items NOT accepted:

- Gasoline
- Prescriptions, Medical Waste/Supplies
- Smoke detectors
- Asbestos
- Ammunition/Gunpowder
- Peroxides over 10% , fertilizer with 27 % or higher ammonium nitrate, cyanides, Chlordane, DDT, Lindane, Silvex (these items can be brought to the permanent facility during normal working hours).
- Waste from a business or municipality
- Cathode Ray Tube type television's and monitors
