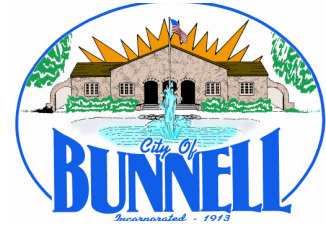

Utility Billing:

**Go Green, Save Postage,
Save time, Pay Online!**

More and more utility customers are utilizing the Online Bill Pay service offered by the City of Bunnell. Since rolling out the service in October 2015, there has been a steady increase in online transactions. Users can go to our home page, www.BunnellCity.us

and click on the Online Bill Pay icon.

Users can make a onetime payment on their account without creating a profile or password. You will need your account number and last payment amount; this information is printed on your bill. You can then use the Quick Pay feature to make a payment. If you are a new customer and this is your first payment you will need to pay in the office or through the US mail to establish a payment history before being able to pay online.

If you are interested in monitoring the consumption on your account, viewing account balances, and transaction history click on the Login button and set up your profile. Make sure you have your bill handy. As with Quick Pay, you will need your account number and last payment amount to set up the profile and link it to your account. You can even monitor and make payments on multiple accounts from a single login.

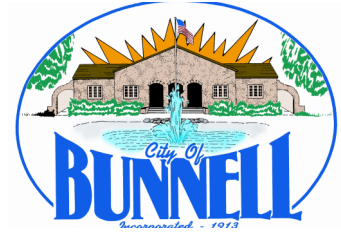


Sandi Bolser retired from her position as City Clerk on December 15, 2017. She was recognized by the City Commission on January 8, 2018 for her years of service .

Another Green Initiative: E-Billing

Another green service that is available to our customers, E-Billing directs your utility bill to your email. This saves paper, printing, postage, staff time, and bills are received quicker. The e-bills are a very similar format as the printed documents so you will not be confused by a new format. When combined with Online Bill Pay, this creates an easy way for our users to manage their accounts.

PUBLIC WORKS PRIDE:

St. John's Wastewater Grant awarded. This will be used specifically for Stormwater diversion, swales, culverts, sewer rehabilitation, and Deen rd. repairs.

Standardized reflective street signs are now being used to replace, damaged or missing signs. Creating a "standard" will help us improve continuity throughout the City.

Hurricane Irma Cleanup was completed on schedule on December 1, 2017. We are pleased to have accomplished this task without the need to hire outside contractors, and especially pleased to offer our assistance to the city of Palm Coast in their clean up efforts.

We continue to utilize volunteers to help clean and improve our city. In January we welcomed Scout Troop 400 to assist with cleanup and landscaping.

Police Department:

Participated in the Veterans Day event at Bunnell Elementary in support of our military heroes.

The Bunnell Police Chief's Burglar Box is a Hit! Other law enforcement agencies across the state have now adopted our creation to help keep their communities safe.

Participated in the Shop With a Cop program on December 15th. Each child is given an amount of money to spend, normally \$100 - \$150 depending on the size of the child's immediate family. Approximately 1-2 children are assigned to each police officer, who then escorts them around the store and assists in selecting appropriate gifts.



In order to Address Crime Together (ACT), the Bunnell Police Department joins a newly established Domestic Violence Summit quarterly meeting hosted by the Flagler County Sheriff's Office for the purposes of finding solutions to reduce domestic violence in our communities.
